

Swedish language training and introduction to health and medical care and dental care

The Liv-spåret project – for new arrivals with health care training within registered professions from outside the EU/EEA.

The project offers Swedish language training combined with other activities to shorten your route towards Swedish professional registration. It will improve your opportunities for working in health and medical care and in dental care.

Contents:

- Swedish language training, specialising in health and medical care.
- Study visits and placements within the county council's operations.
- Practical training at the county council's clinical training centre or at a dental clinic.

Intake for the project is planned to take place twice a year. Applicants will be selected through matching against the county council's staffing needs.

Applicants should:

- Have a professional qualification within health and medical care or dental care from outside the EU/EEA.
- Knowledge of the Swedish language, equivalent to Swedish for Immigrants D (SFI D).
- Be registered with Arbetsförmedlingen.

The project is a collaboration between Arbetsförmedlingen, Värmland County Council and Folkuniversitetet. It is being financed with support from the European Social Fund.
